



SKATETOWN'S CAMP COOL 2010 PARENT PACKET

Sign In/Out Procedure. Camp hours 9am-5pm. No child care prior to 9am.

- Please sign your child in each morning, noting the name/phone number of the person who is authorized to pick them up that day. **Photo IDs will be checked when the child is signed out. The sign-out book will be in the party rooms in the afternoon.** Campers are not allowed to leave the facility. There is one adult counselor for every 15 campers. **Campers not picked up by 5pm will incur a \$1 per minute charge starting at 5pm.**

Spending Money

- If your child has spending money, please place the money in an envelope (to be provided) and leave the money with our cashier. Your child can ask for the money at any time.

What to Bring

- Campers should wear warm clothes, one pair of tall, thin socks and bring gloves or mittens.
- Extra clothes. Depending on the temperature outdoors, we are planning to have lunch outside. Please bring sandals, hat, sunglasses and a change of clothes including shorts and t-shirt. Be sure to label all of your belongings that you bring to Camp!
- Please wear your Camp Cool t-shirt every day. (The paints we use to paint the ice and snow are all washable)

Skatetown Café

- Campers will need to bring snacks and a lunch or pre-purchase a meal at the Skatetown Café (approx. \$7). Please note that the café will not be open, so lunch orders will need to be prepaid by 10 am.
- If you choose not to bring a lunch, prepaying for your camper's lunch each morning will help prevent your child from losing money during the camp day or using the money for video games instead of food. You can pre-purchase lunch at the front desk when you drop your camper off in the morning.
- Campers may want to bring change for video games and a snack.
- Campers will get one free beverage each day (hot chocolate or soda).

Structured On-Ice Activities 9:30 am—noon and 2-3:30 pm

Each morning from 9:30 am until noon, there are fun group activities for all campers. We request that *all* campers participate with the group. Campers who do not wish to participate can sit on the bleachers and watch or sit in the café area. We ask that you remind your camper that he/she needs to participate fully and be in one of the two designated areas. Campers roaming around the rink unsupervised will be asked to call their parent(s) to be picked up.

Video Games

Skatetown has a variety of games in the video arcade but please note that campers will be asked to refrain from playing until after lunch at noon time. The games are play-at-your-own-risk; no refunds will be given.

Camp Cool Club Off-Ice Activities

The Camp Cool Club is a great place to warm up and relax when not skating. Daily activities may include videos, board games, card games, art and more. Camper's backpacks, lunches and other gear will be kept in the Camp Cool Club rooms.

Camper Behavior

In order to provide a positive and safe experience for all campers, it is essential that all rules are understood and followed. **Please review the following camp rules with your child:**

- Campers are required to be polite and respectful to each other and to the facility. Campers who act inappropriately toward a person or who intentionally cause damage to the facility will not be allowed to continue attending camp. **No refunds will be issued to campers who miss any portion of camp due to their behavior.**
- Campers must be able to follow directions given by camp counselors or staff.
- Campers are NOT permitted to be in the front lobby area or in the ProShop unless accompanied by a parent.
- Campers are NOT permitted to exit the facility unless they are with a counselor. Campers do eat outside in the patio area under umbrellas, but there is always a counselor with them.
